

Competition Evacuation Plan

We have coordinated with the Anthony's Key Resort Clinic which is a private clinic familiar with freediving related emergencies and the access point is St Simon Club. The emergency room is 8km in distance (20 minutes) from the access point. The dive site is approximately 1,5 km from access point. Total time from dive site to access point is approximately 5 minutes.

Step	Training Day	Competition Day
1 Handling of unresponsive athlete and evacuation	Seafly Team	Competition Doctor and safety team assuring that proper and continuous care is being given to the patient
2 Sea evacuation	Athlete's boat once disconnected from platforms Fast evacuation vessel piloted by paramedics (approximately 5 minutes)	Fast evacuation vessel piloted by paramedics (approximately 5 minutes)
3 Land evacuation	Private car stationed on St Simon Beach Club parking – key with emergency phone	Ambulance stationed in St Simon Beach club during the whole competition period
4 Medical facility	Athlete will be transported from St Simon Beach Club to Anthony's Key Resort (or Wood's medical clinic) where doctors will be waiting for arrival of patient
